WHAT IS INCLUDED IN YOUR FEES?

PSA is a one-stop shop for great soccer and your fees cover a first-class experience. Included are the following:

- Assignment of a hand-picked coach and all coaching fees (covering late August through June). Each coach is chosen based on the developmental needs of the children. Coaches receive ongoing evaluation and educational support from our full time Director of Coaching.
- One club training per week to supplement formal team training. Winter training will utilize gym and outdoor turf fields. Teams often choose to train in addition to the club mandated session.
- League fees for the entire year.
- Match fields for the entire season on terrific surfaces. PSA is a proud partner with the Maryland SoccerPlex.
- Maryland State Youth Soccer Association fees and MD registrar fees.
- Technical and separate goalkeeper trainings with licensed, talented coaches.
- Participation in the nationally recognized Adidas Potomac Memorial Day Tournament.
- Attendance at an annual "college" preparation forum.
- Twice yearly formal individual player evaluations.
- A team tournament credit of \$500 (U8-U14) & \$1,000 (U15+) which covers most entrance fees and encourages additional competition in first class regional events.
